

Brown Marmorated Stink Bug Awarenes Raising and Collaboration Meetings

Awareness efforts regarding the brown marmorated stink bug are ongoing!

The "Brown Marmorated Stink Bug Panel," organized by the <u>Düzce Provincial Directorate of Agriculture</u> and Forestry with the support of the Istanbul Exporters' Association and Balsu, took place. The meeting addressed awareness and collaboration activities concerning the brown marmorated stink bug, which poses a significant threat to the hazelnut sector.

The panel was attended by the Governor of Düzce, the General Director of Food and Control, the Provincial Director of Agriculture and Forestry for Düzce, officials from Agricultural Provincial Directorates, university faculty members, the Istanbul Hazelnut Exporters' Association, private sector representatives, non-governmental organizations, and hazelnut farmers.

Dr. Kibar Ak from Ondokuz Mayıs University provided technical information about the brown marmorated stink bug and discussed methods of combating it. Additionally, the Provincial Agriculture Directorates shared their efforts in combating the brown marmorated stink bug during the panel.

As part of his visit to Western Black Sea region districts, Dr. Kibar Ak participated in informative meetings organized by Balsu for registered farmers in the sustainable agriculture program. These meetings included discussions on techniques for combatting the invasive pest.

The battle against the brown marmorated stink bug is of paramount importance to the hazelnut sector's future. Balsu continues to collaborate to find effective solutions to address this critical issue.

As part of the project, a technical tour began with the visit of farmers to Balsu's factory, followed by informative sessions on hazelnut post-harvest practices.
